

DIRECTIONS FROM HANEDA TO CITYTEL HOTEL MUSASHISAKAI

If you are arriving at Haneda Airport, take the Keihin Kyuko Train 京浜急行電鉄 (Keikyuu for short), transfer at Shinagawa station, and get off at Tokyo station.

The Arrival lobby and Keikyuu stations are both located on the 2nd Floor.

Please make sure to take the Keikyuu Train- NOT the Tokyo Monorail that is on the same Floor.

Time: 1.5 hours



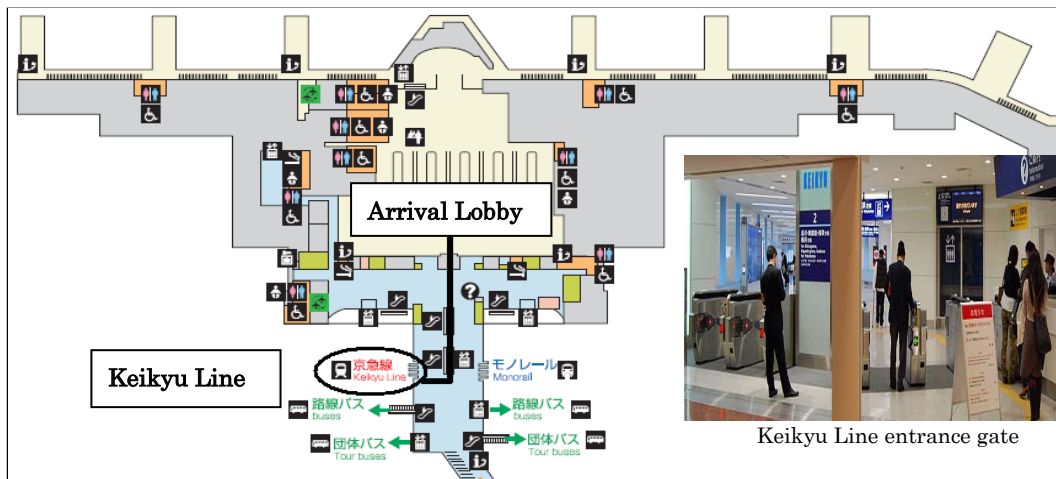
Haneda Airport Int'l Terminal Station

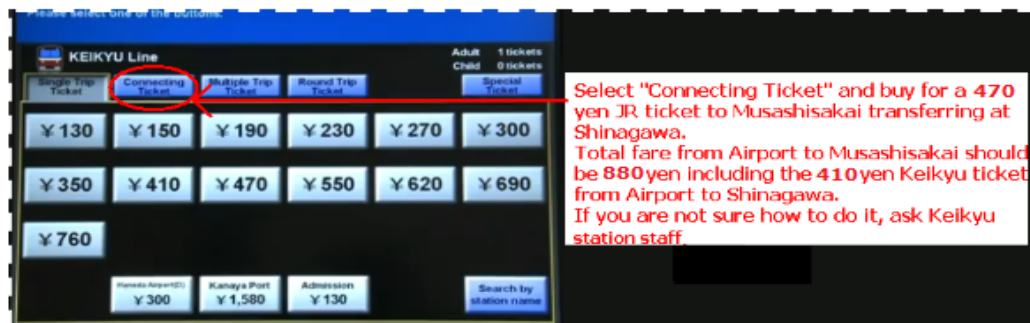

Keikyuu Line entrance gate

At the ticket vending machine, buy a “connecting ticket” to JR Musashisakai Station via Shinagawa Station in order to make it simple and easy to transfer at Shinagawa. The total fare from Haneda airport to Musashisakai is 880 yen, if paying cash. From Haneda to Shinagawa is 410 yen, from Shinagawa to Musashisakai is 470 yen.



Select "Connecting Ticket" and buy for a 470 yen JR ticket to Musashisakai transferring at Shinagawa.
Total fare from Airport to Musashisakai should be 880 yen including the 410 yen Keikyuu ticket from Airport to Shinagawa.
If you are not sure how to do it, ask Keikyuu station staff

Check for the track number once again— trains leave from track #2 every 5-10 minutes.

*Carefully check the overhead screen and ONLY take trains whose destinations are: Narita 成田, Narita Airport 成田空港, Via Narita SKY ACCESS Line 成田スカイアクセス線 經由成田空港, Inba Nihon Idai 印旛日本医大, Inzai Makinohara 印西牧の原, Aoto 青砥, Sengakuji 泉岳寺, Shinagawa 品川, and Takasago 高砂.

These trains will arrive at Shinagawa station while other trains won't.

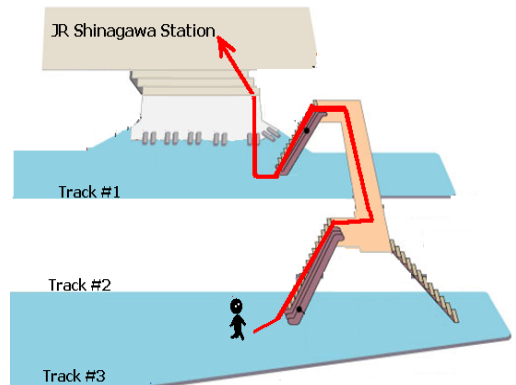


These 9 trains go towards Shinagawa. It's a 20 minute ride to Shinagawa by Express 急行 train and 13 minutes by Ltd. Express 快特 train.



Keikyu Shinagawa Station (品川駅)

At Shinagawa Station, you'll arrive at track #2. Find the escalator/stairs located in the middle of the platform and cross over track #1 to transfer to JR line. Walk through a ticket gate to enter JR Shinagawa Station. When passing through the ticket gate, don't forget to insert and collect your "connecting ticket".

Take a Yamanote line 山手線 train going toward Tokyo on platform #1— trains leave every 3-5 minutes.

Tokyo Station is the 5th stop from Shinagawa Station.

From Musashisakai station to Citytel: At Musashi-sakai station, go downstairs to the ground level and follow the signs for the SOUTH EXIT. You'll either see "Newdays", a convenience store, on your left and/or "Emio", a food market complex on your right hand side. Turn right at "Emio" and go straight along with "Emio" on your right. On the left will be an open space where kids like to run around. Within a minute or so, you'll see Citytel Hotel on your left. The picture on the left below shows the street entrance to the Hotel.
