DIRECTIONS FROM NARITA AIRPORT TO HOTEL METS, MUSASHISAKAI

The fastest and most direct way is to take the JR Narita Express (N'EX) to get to Tokyo from Narita Airport. Both Terminal 1 and 2 have JR stations directly connected from the arrival lobbies. N'EX runs every 30 minutes.

Please purchase tickets to JR Musashisakai Station at Narita Airport JR Line Ticket Counters.

Please note that the last Narita Express leaves at 21:44pm, so if your flight arrives after 7pm, it might be better to consider

booking a hotel in the Narita area.

(Taxis from Narita can be extremely expensive.)




← Ticket counter at JR Narita Airport Station (Terminal 1)



← Ticket counter at JR Airport Terminal 2 Station (Terminal 2)


JR Narita Airport Station



If you are at Terminal 1, N'EXs "Narita Airport Station" is the closest station for you. For example, if you flew in with <u>United</u>, <u>Singapore</u> or <u>Delta Airlines</u>, it is most likely that you are at **Terminal 1**.

JR Airport Terminal 2 Station







Even though there is a free shuttle service between 1st and the 2nd Terminals of Narita Airport, you do not need to worry about taking one. Every N'EX stops at both "Narita Airport Station" and "Airport Terminal 2 Station". Examples of the airlines arrive at **Terminal 2** are <u>China</u>, <u>American</u> and <u>Japan Airlines</u>.

JR Tokyo Station (東京駅)

Since Tokyo Station is the starting station for Chuo Line, it is <u>strongly recommended</u> that you transfer at this station. Because of this, you are more likely to get seats, and the train is less crowded (really!!)

Approx. 40 min.

After getting off the N'EX at Tokyo Station, go up the stairs and look for platforms 1 and 2. It's easier to find Chuo Line when you look for the orange signs, the color for Chuo Line(中央線). Don't get confused by the Tokaido line.

Take ONLY "Rapid(快速)" trains since other trains won't stop at Musashisakai Station.
